



The Draught of a tract of land situate in the east end of Nittany Valley Bald Eagle Township Centre County containing three hundred and twenty three acres ninty two perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c<sup>s</sup> surveyed the first day of April 1813 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Wilson dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1812, The above survey includes an improvement made in November 1808 consisting of a Cabbin house and stable and about twenty acres of plow-land under cultivation and a family actualy residing thereon.
