



Situate in the last purchase District No 4. Joining the South end of Wm Bingham & Company on the Waters of the Conongdaw Creek. Surveyed the third day of July 1793
 In pursuance of a Warrant No 2380 to Wilhem Willihit, Nicholaas Van Staphorst Christiaan Van Eggen, Hendriht Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam. Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 A.S. Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct for Roads &c.
