



Situate in Union Township Huntingdon County Containing Ninety one Acres 55 perches & the usual allowance of Six per Cent. It being part of a tract of Land. Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Thomas Hiez Luckert dated the 15th day of January 1794. The Whole Survey at that time was Said to Contain 148 Acres 112 perches & allowance. This part Resurveyed & divided of from the whole tract the 26th day of March 1840.
