



Situate in Brush Valley, Miles township Centre County Containing eighty seven Acres, nineteen perches and allowance of six per Cent & 2/3. Surveyed the 11th day of August 1819, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Gramley bearing date the 29th day of July A.D. 1819. Note the improvement on the above described tract of land at the time of making the Survey Consisted of a dwelling house, Hewed logs, Shingled roof, a stable, a young orchard, and about eight or ten Acres of Cleared land. Said to be first improved in Dec^r 1809, and Jacob Gramley & family actually residing on the same
