I have been instructed by Mr. George James' council to return this survey in dispute, and claimed by said George James on a prior right. you will also understand that I returned a survey this day for the same piece of land. Surveyed on a warrant granted to George James for 3½ acres dated the 30th of April 1851. I not knowing at that time that a second, or that two warrants had been issued for the same piece of land, or would ^{have} returned boeth surveys together. May 3rd 1851
