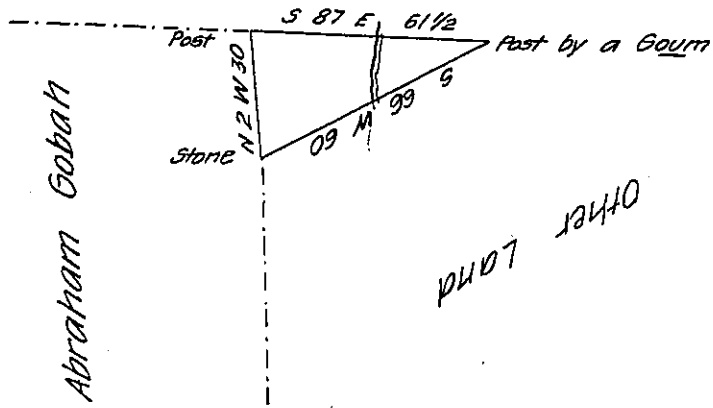


James Willsons

 Surveyor, as appears by his Official Draught Remaining in my Office the above

 Five Acres and One Quarter and allowance of Six Pr. Cent for Roads &c.
