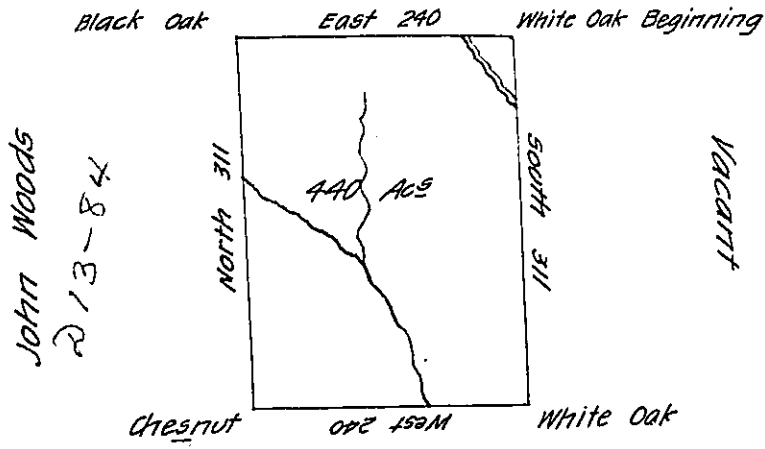

The above is a draught of a Survey made April the first day 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Woods J<sup>r</sup> dated February the 10<sup>th</sup> 1794 Adjoining John Woods to the Eastward and including the head waters of a stream emptying into the Allegheny-Situate North and West of the River Ohio Allegheny and Comawango Creek on the Waters of Pine Creek in District No 9 Called Round and forty Bottom containing four hundred Acres together with the usual allowance of six Per Cent for Roads.
