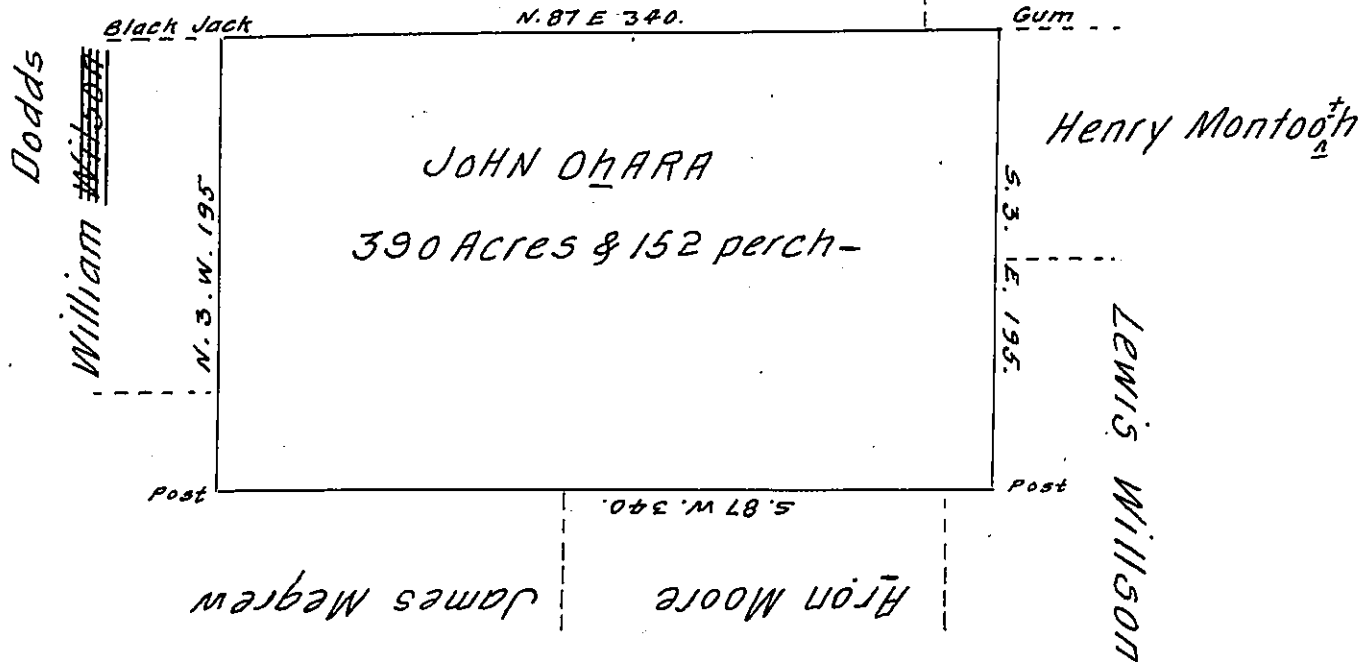

The above appears to be a Survey made to John Ohara on the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 1805.  
In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to him, and Dated the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of Jan<sup>r</sup> 1805.  
Containing 390 Acres & 152 perch- with the usual Allowance &c. Situate  
in Coneguenessing Township Butler County.

N.B. The Above Survey on the Warrant Granted to John Ohara appears to  
have been Executed by James Ervin Esq<sup>r</sup> Late Deputy Surveyor but  
not Entered in the Survey Book, but mearly taken from a Loos Draft  
that was Delivered to me with the Books.
