



A draught of a tract of land situate in Ulster Township Bradford County containing Sixty two acres and one hundred and forty five perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads including an improvement of John Snyder begun the first day of December 1788 consisting of a dwelling house the residence of a family - a Barn and about forty acres of Improved land. Surveyed to John Snyder the 6th day of December 1820 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 30th day of November 1820 by

N.B. The above described tract of land is part of a tract formerly surveyed by Charles Stewart late D.S. to Charles Harris in 1773. It lies within the Township of Ulster one of the Seventeen Townships and has been ^{by the former warrant holder} relinquished under the compromising law of April 1799 and its Supplements to the Commonwealth.
