



In Pursuance of an Order from the Secretary there was Surveyed for Thomas Wilson in The Town of Carlisle in Cumberland County a Certain Lot of Ground Containing in Length East & West Two Hundred and forty feet and in Breadth North and South Sixty feet. Bounded Northward by Lot No 154. Eastward by Hanover Street. Southward by a Twenty foot Alley. and Westward by Lot No 128. and Marked in the plan of the Said Town No 153.
