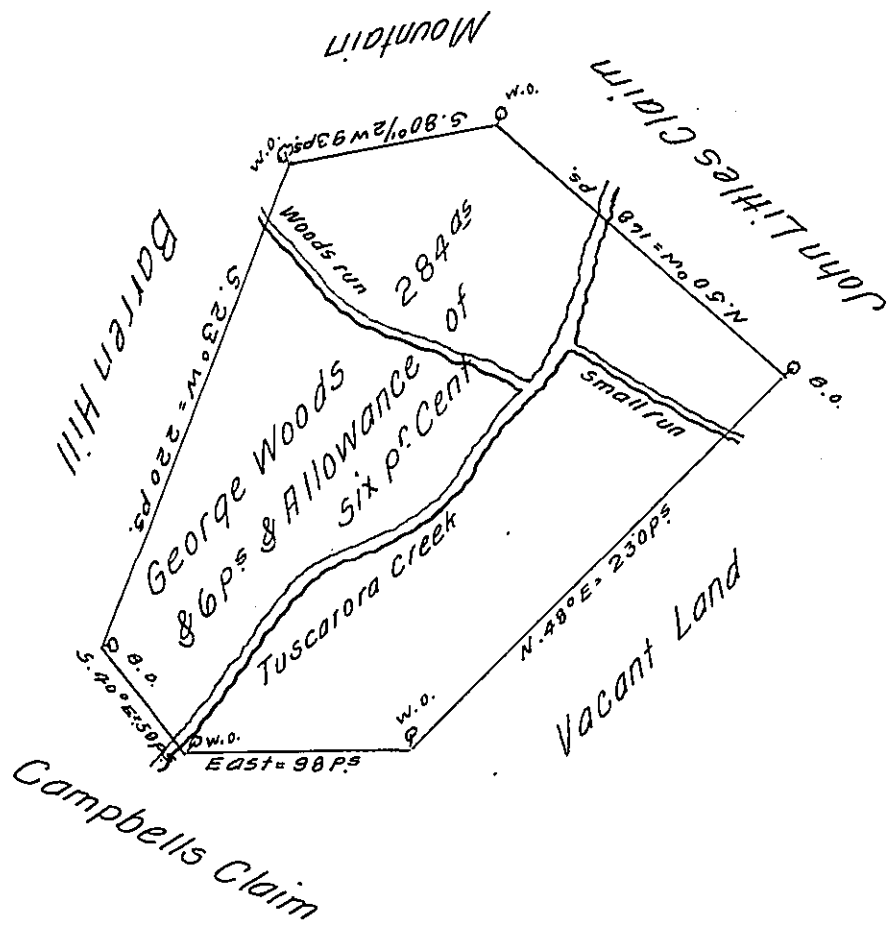


This Survey is interfered with by one since made for Alexander McIntyre, who had an Hearing at the Board of Property with John Glen Owner of this Land.
