



A Draught of A Tract of Land in Greenfield Township Erie County on the Waters of Lake Erie. Surveyed the 12th day of October 1801 for Robert Burres by virtue of his Actual Settlement and Improvement And Resurveyed the 18th day of August 1802. in pursuance of A Warrant granted to the said Robert Burres dated the 5th day of March 1802, agreeable to the old lines. Containing 390 Acres and Allowance &c. It being the same tract that was heretofore granted to William Smith druggist and said to have been surveyed on his Warrant dated the 13th day of April 1792. Who hath not complied with the conditions of Said Warrant and the 9th Section of the Act of the 3^d of April 1792.
