



In pursuance of a warrant to Samuel Wallis, Esq<sup>r</sup>, Nº 4150, dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October 1793, and the decree of the board of Property of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September, 1812, and the order of the Surveyor General thereon founded to me directed. Resurveyed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 1812 the above described tract of land containing nine hundred and ninety acres and ninety perches and allowance of six per cent & ca. Situate on the waters of the Sinnemahoning- in the late purchase Lycoming County, Dunstable township.
