



Draft of a tract of land containing fifty five acres and 148perches and allowance of six per cent for roads & situated in Albany Township, county of Bradford and State of Pa. Surveyed August 30th, 1871, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Wells Willcox the 25th day of May, 1871, of the above tract all the land being the South West side of the South Branch of Towanda Creek of 25 acres and 56 perches and allowance of six per cent upon which there is an improvement of the Major part commenced about forty years since is claimed by one Bahr who I understand does not object to a patent issuing of the land lying North East of said Creek being 30 acres 92 perches and allowance upon which there has been a clearing not now enclosed of between three and four acres is claimed by one J.S. Campbell who has no title so far as I can learn by settlement or otherwise.
