



Surveyed the above described tract of Land on the 6th day of October, 1815, for Jacob Brosus in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Williams, bearing date the 21st January 1796, - Containing one hundred and twenty two acres & Six perch and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c, Situated in Nippinose Valley Wain (formerly part of Nippinose) Township, Lycoming County, bounded as above described, - Note the improvement is a house with a family residing therein and about twenty five acres cleared Land, - The improvement began by John Williams in the year 1792.
