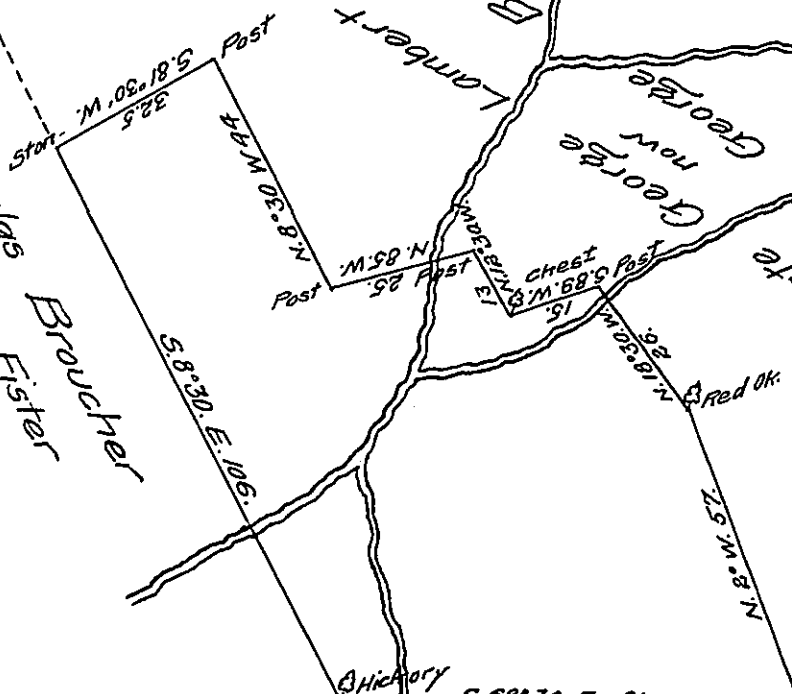

Kunkle on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1867, being part of a larger tract of One hundred and eighty three acres ninety five perches and allowance Originally Surveyed in pursuance of two Warrants one granted to Daniel Young dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 1749, the other granted to George Lambert dated the 13<sup>th</sup> June 1750.
