



Situate in Taylor Township Fulton County Con-
 taining 101^{as} 82^{ps} and allowance of Six per Cent
 for Roads &c. Originally Survey on a warrant-
 to Jacob Wolf Jr. Resurveyed In pursuance of an
 order of the Board of Property dated the 18th
 day December 1843 directing the Surveyor
 General to reject the survey made on Wolfs
 warrant and cause a new survey to be made for
 100^{as} in conformity to an agreement entered in-
 to (by the parties) Adam Weidman and Wolf. Resur-
 veyed the 31st day of December 1855 in presence of Adam
 Weidman and William McDonald. A line of Wolf the above
 includes George Lackart improvement made 1812.
