



Draught of two hundred and forty nine acres and seventy four perches of land with 6 1/2 Cent for roads situate in Millford township in Mifflin County, Surveyed 20th March 1790 by Samuel Lyon late D.S. in pursuance of a warrant to John Patton dated on the 23^d August 1785. Examined 5th July 1808.

Note - that part struck off by the dotted line containing 39²/₁₃ perches has ^{been} adjudged by the Honorable the Board of property on monday 1st August 1808 to be the property of William Kinny and Charles O'Hara - being included the survey of Kinny & O'hara.
