



SITUATE on the waters of Sheavers Creek in Baree Township in the County of Huntingdon containing one hundred & Twenty nine acres one hundred and fifty six perches and the usual allowance for Roads Resurveyed the 25th day of March 1809 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th day of September 1762. And of an order of the Board of Property on the Petition of John Q. McKnight dated the 8th day of October 1808.
