



Situated on the North East Branch of Dummings
Creek near the Two Bottoms (formerly in Cumberland) now
Bedford County Containing 544 Acres & 167 perches
with the allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c.
(being one of the Tracts within the Boundaries of
a large Survey made for George Croghan May
22^d 1766 by Richard Tea's Deputy) Resurveyed
September 7th 1797 on Warrant Dated June 1st 1763
granted to Frederick Snyder.

N.B. a Survey in the Name of James
Sterling made March 27th 1767 on Order - George Woods D.S.
dated Sept. 26th 1766. interferes with
the above Survey.
