



SITUATE on the waters of Little Aughwick at the foot of Tuscarora Mountain Joining land of Hugh Davison Esquire & others in Dublin Township in the County of Huntingdon Containing one hundred & Sixty seven acres and the usual allowance for Roads. Surveyed the 11th day of May 1792 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 25th day of April 1792.

Note - this survey Interferes with a survey of John Ramsays as far as the Doted lines the remainder of the survey John Ramsay claims in virtue of an Improvement.
