Surveyed for Frederick Fretz on Warrant dated the 31st day of May 1762

The dotted lines represent part of the draught of a tract of land surveyed for William Hopkins on Order No 268 dated the 1st day of August 1766 This tract interferes Eighteen acres and Twelve perches with the Frederick Fretz survey - William Hopkins conveyed to Sam^l Wallace who conveyed to Abel James and Henry Drinker. Abel James conveyed to Henry Drinker who appears to have abandoned his claim to the interference
