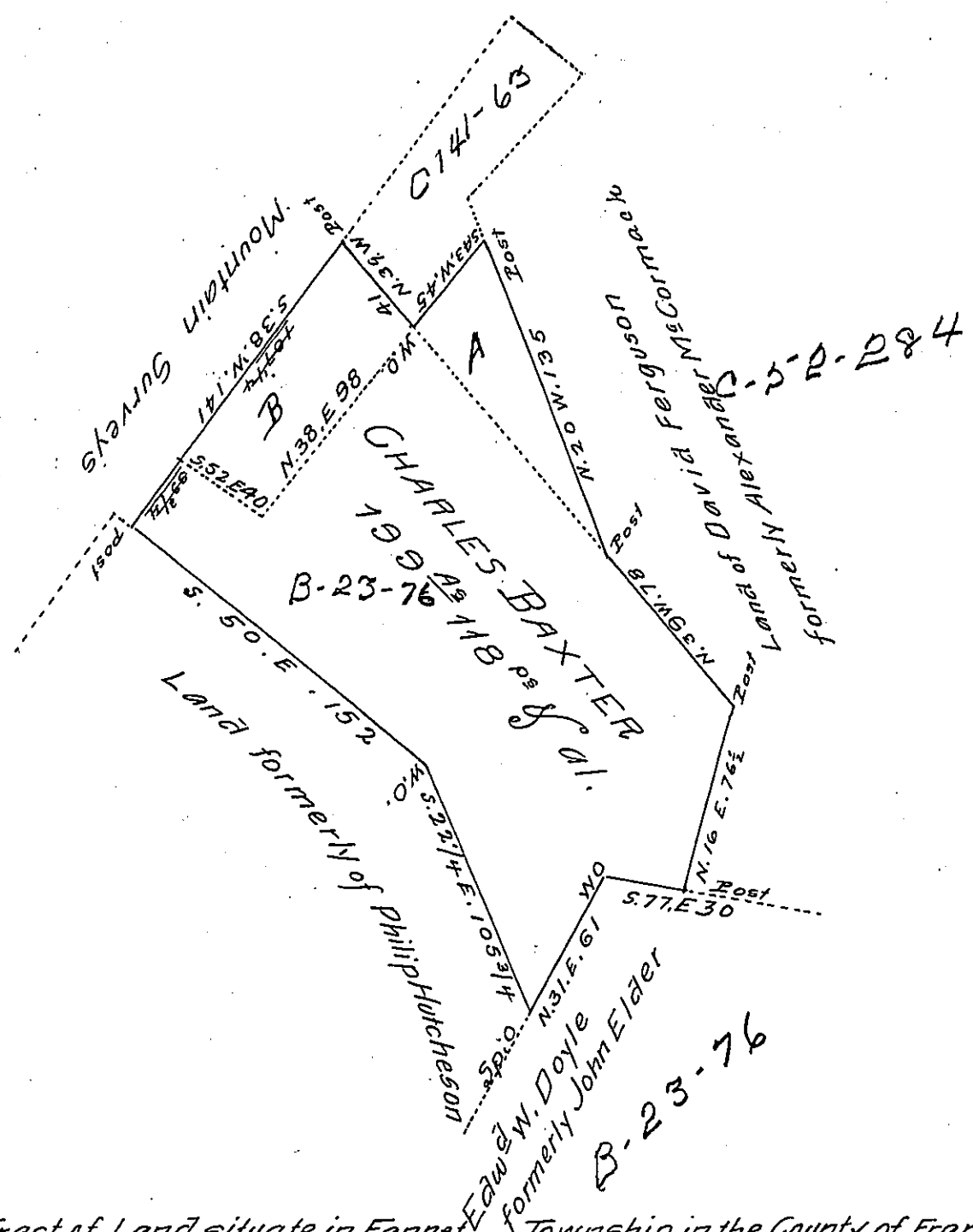


FORM NO. 1.



Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Fanner Township in the County of Franklin containing One hundred & Ninety nine acres & One hundred and eighteen perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed 27th October 1829 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under Proprietary right &c. And by Virtue of a Warrant dated 29th April 1763 granted Charles Baxter for 200 Acres "joining Philip Hutchison Alexander McCormack and John Elder in Path Valley" Resurveyed agreeable to lines Surveyed 15 June 1763 including the additional Triangle A. not claimed by any other person than the present owner under the above Warrant
