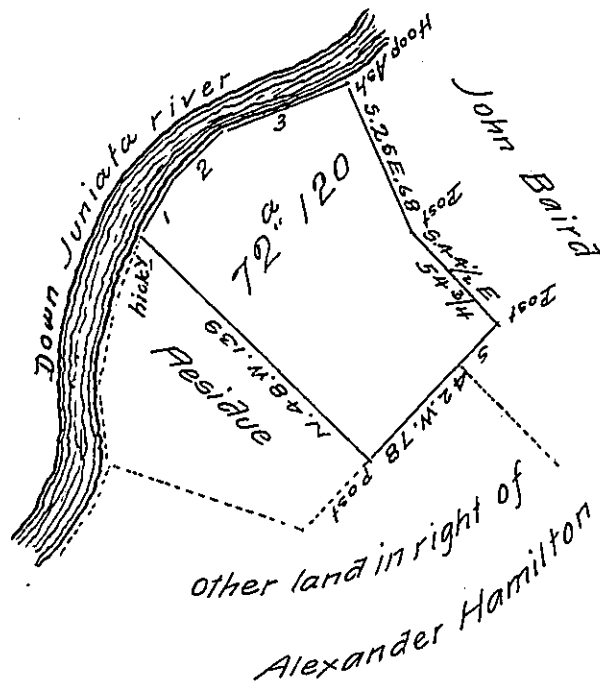

*Draft of Seventy two acres and One hundred and twenty perches of land with six per Cent for roads. Situate in Wayne Township in Mifflin County, which is part of a tract of land surveyed 5<sup>th</sup> July 1769 warrant to Alexander Hamilton dated 10<sup>th</sup> February 1755 said to contain 104<sup>2</sup>/<sub>5</sub> acres but found to contain upon resurvey of the original lines 118<sup>a</sup> & 14.4 perches. Resurveyed the above part agreeably to the original lines on the ground 10<sup>th</sup> July 1817*
