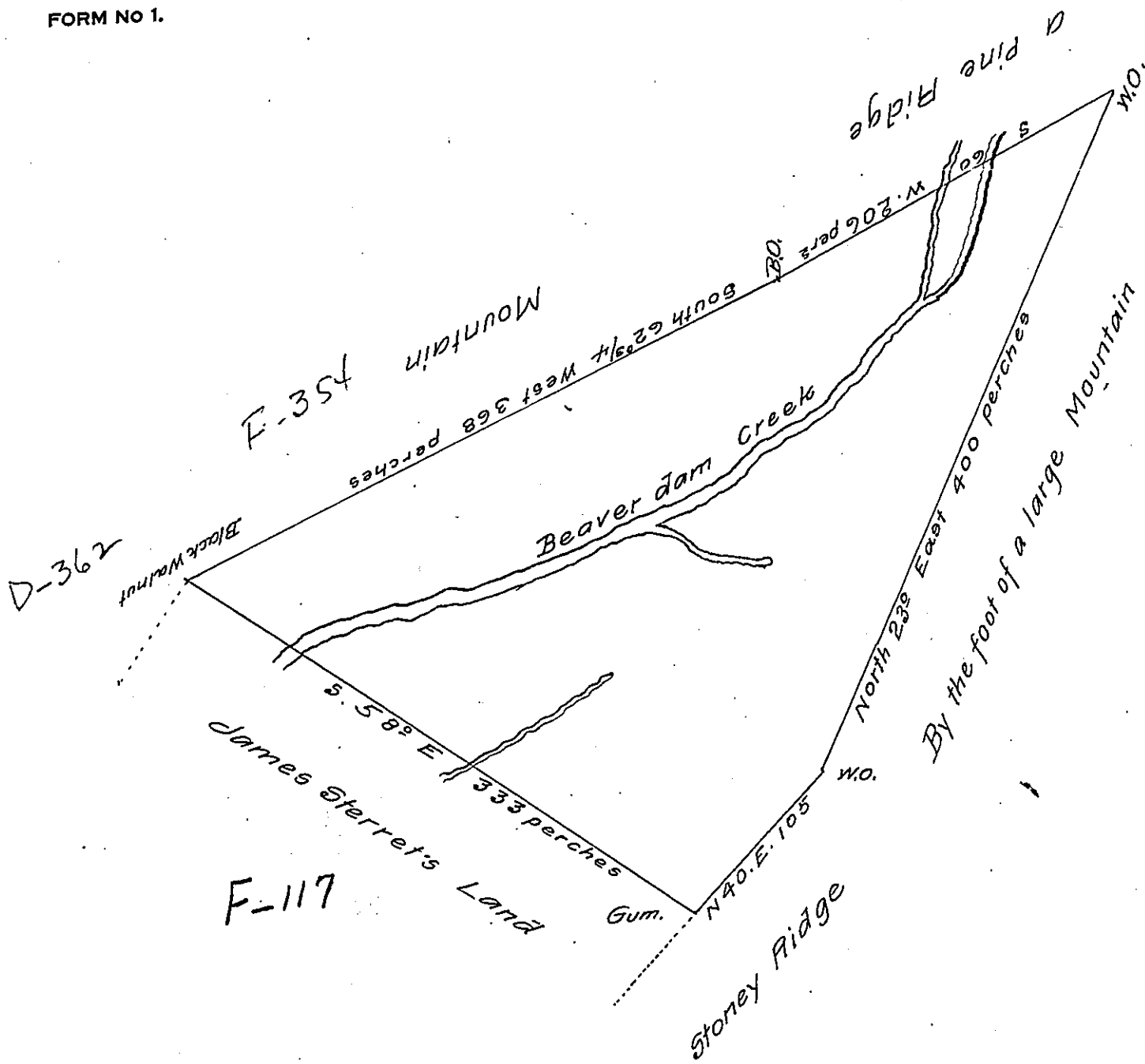


FORM NO 1.



A Draught of a Tract of land situate on the Beaver Dam Creek a Branch of Frankstown Creek about five miles from Frankstown in the County of Cumberland containing Five hundred and fifteen acres and twenty perches and the usual allowance of six acres p<sup>ct</sup> for roads &c.<sup>s</sup> Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1765 to Samuel and Robert Johnson in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1762
