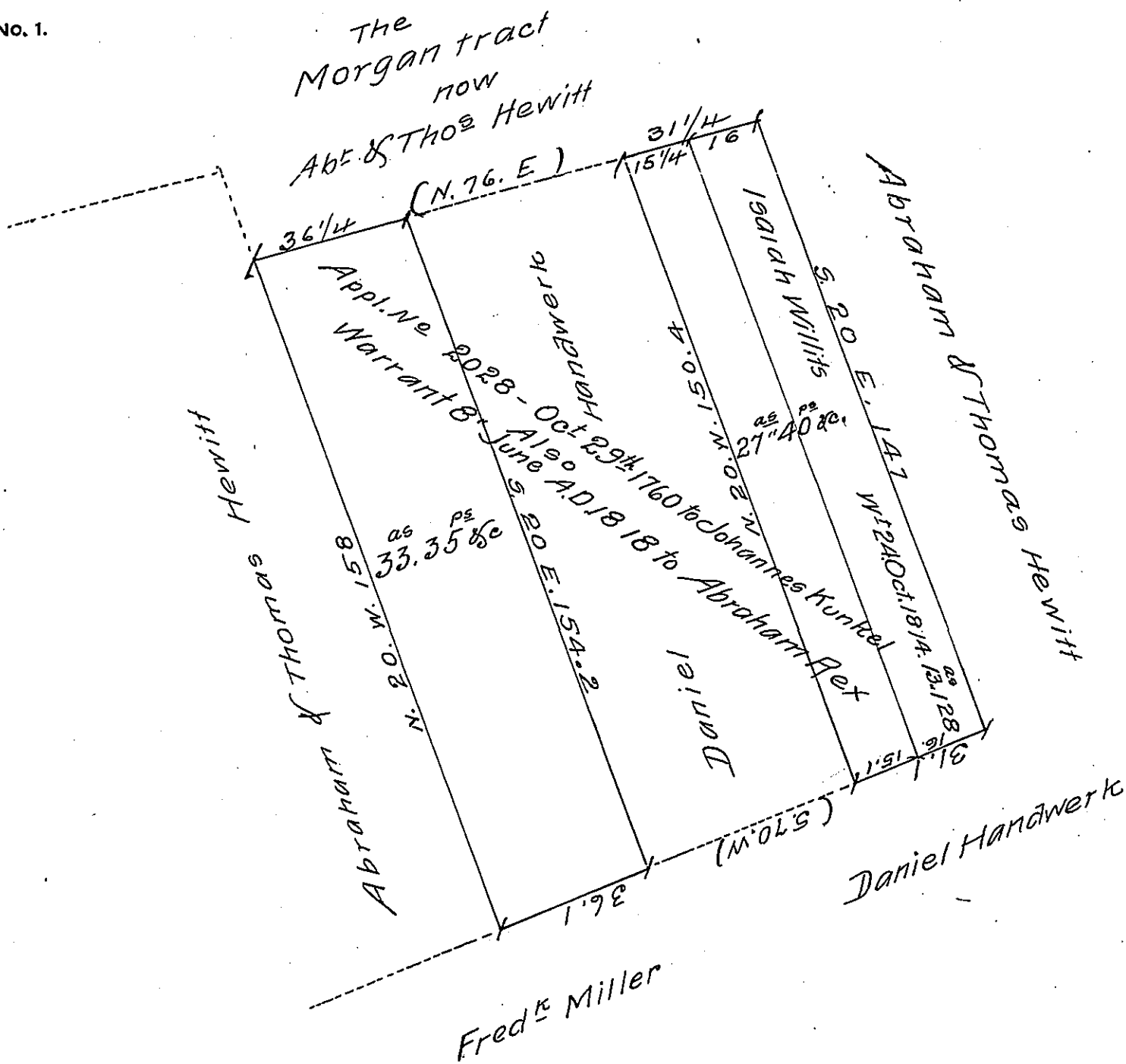


FORM No. 1.



Draft of two tracts of land situate in Washington (late Heidelberg) township Lehigh County containing together 60<sup>ac</sup> 75<sup>ps</sup> and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. of which 13<sup>ac</sup> 128<sup>ps</sup> &c. was originally surveyed to Isaiah Willis by Warrant dated Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1814 - and the balance (46<sup>ac</sup> 116<sup>ps</sup> &c.) being a part of a larger tract of 91<sup>1/4</sup> acres and allowance, Originally surveyed in pursuance and by virtue of Application No 2028 entered the 29<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. A.D. 1766 in the name of Johannes Kunkel and was also surveyed to Abraham Rex by Warrant dated June 8<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1818
