S. on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> Month A.D. 1771 in pursuance of the application of Anthony Kirkhart N<sup>o</sup> 4913 dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1768 - The above part having been examined, calculated, and a return of the same made out by Jacob Spangler late D. S. but said return not having been forwarded to the Surveyor General's office in due season, the same is now reexamined found correct and returned for Confirmation at the request of the present owner.
