



Situate on the North Fork of Turkeyfoot about the line of Milford and Turkeyfoot Townships in the County of Somerset containing forty four acres and allowance and surveyed at the instance of John King on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April 1845 in pursuance of a Warrant granted in the name of Henry Whipkey bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 1840 and returned <sup>at</sup> ~~at~~ that time to Jacob Sallade Esq Surveyor General by H.L. Holbrook Deputy but having contained an error it was sent back for correction in Sept. 1853 and said error being corrected it is now
