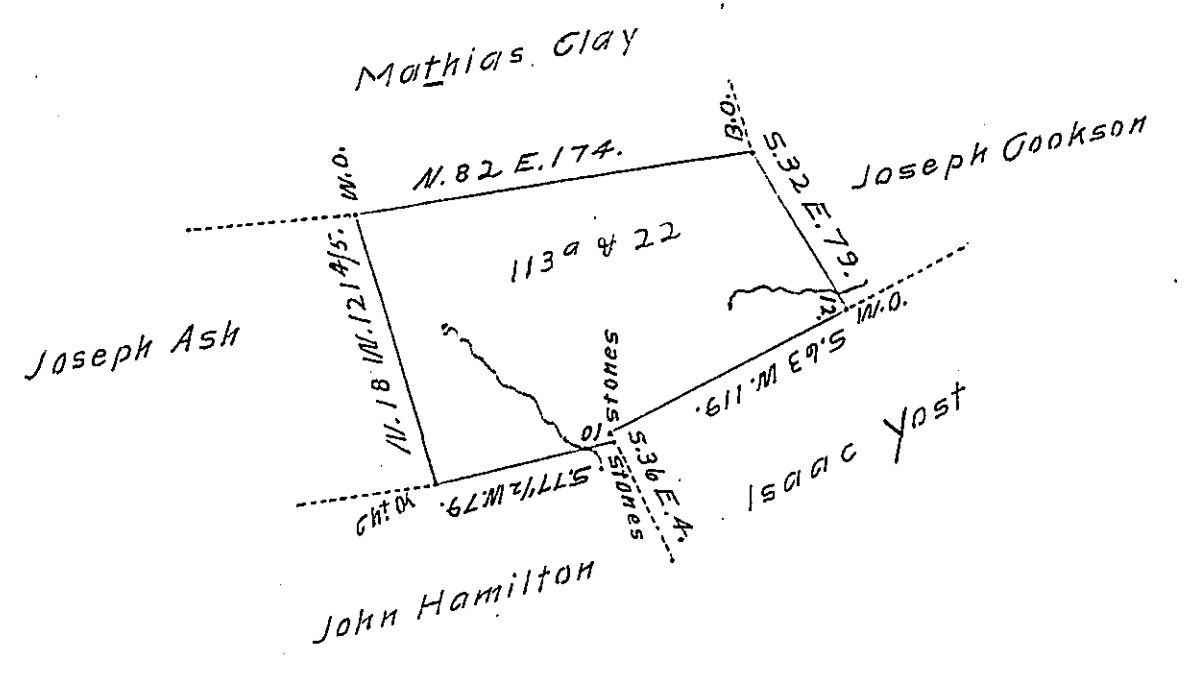


FORM NO 1.



A Draught of one hundred and thirteen acres and twenty two perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Fermanagh township in Mifflin County surveyed 9th March 1812 in pursuance of a warrant to Jacob Zugg dated 16th January 1812. Note, on the above described land there are a large dwelling^{house} with a family in it, a double barn and about fifty acres of cleared land under fence and in a state of cultivation.
