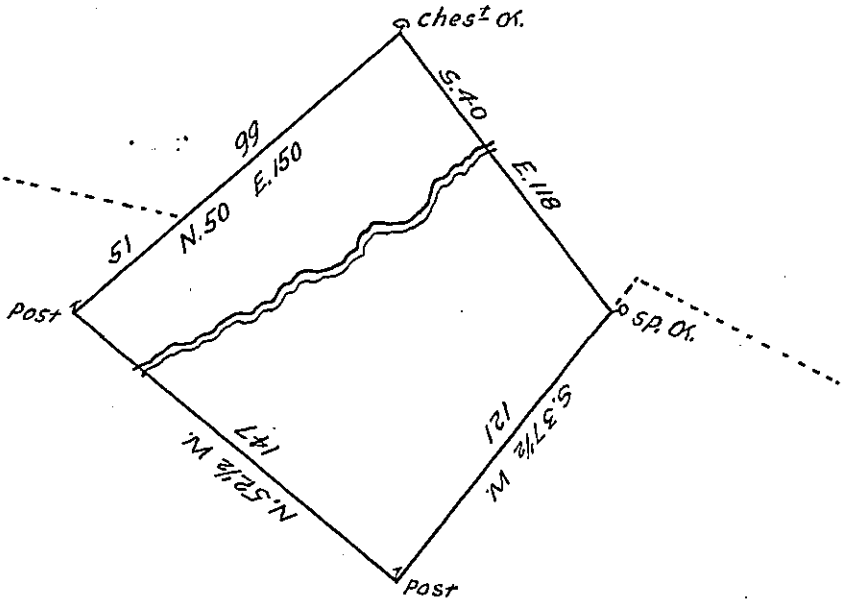


Vacant Land

By virtue of a warrant dated the 21 February 1794 Surveyed
 the 16 June 1794 to Matthew Ryon the above described tract of land situ-
 ate on a branch of Ramys hill including two Sawmills known by the
 name of Kirbrightt and Westbrook's Sawmills about three miles and an
 half from Delawane in Northampton County Containing One hundred and
 four Acres ninety perches and the allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. &c.
