S. for Joshua Russell the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1770 in pursuance of a warrant for 275.<sup>a</sup> dated March 28<sup>th</sup> 1775 and dividid as above in 1799 by Moses McClean my predecessor. Examined and certified this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1801.
