



Situate in Mannheim Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 10^{ac} & 18 perches and allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of Land which was originally surveyed by Archibald McClean late D.S., on the 5th day of September 1771. In pursuance of a warrant for 50^{ac} granted to Francis Hochstoedler bearing date the 4th day of October 1771. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land the 26th & 27th days of April 1809 for Peter Krep's the present owner who desired me to make return of the Draught.
