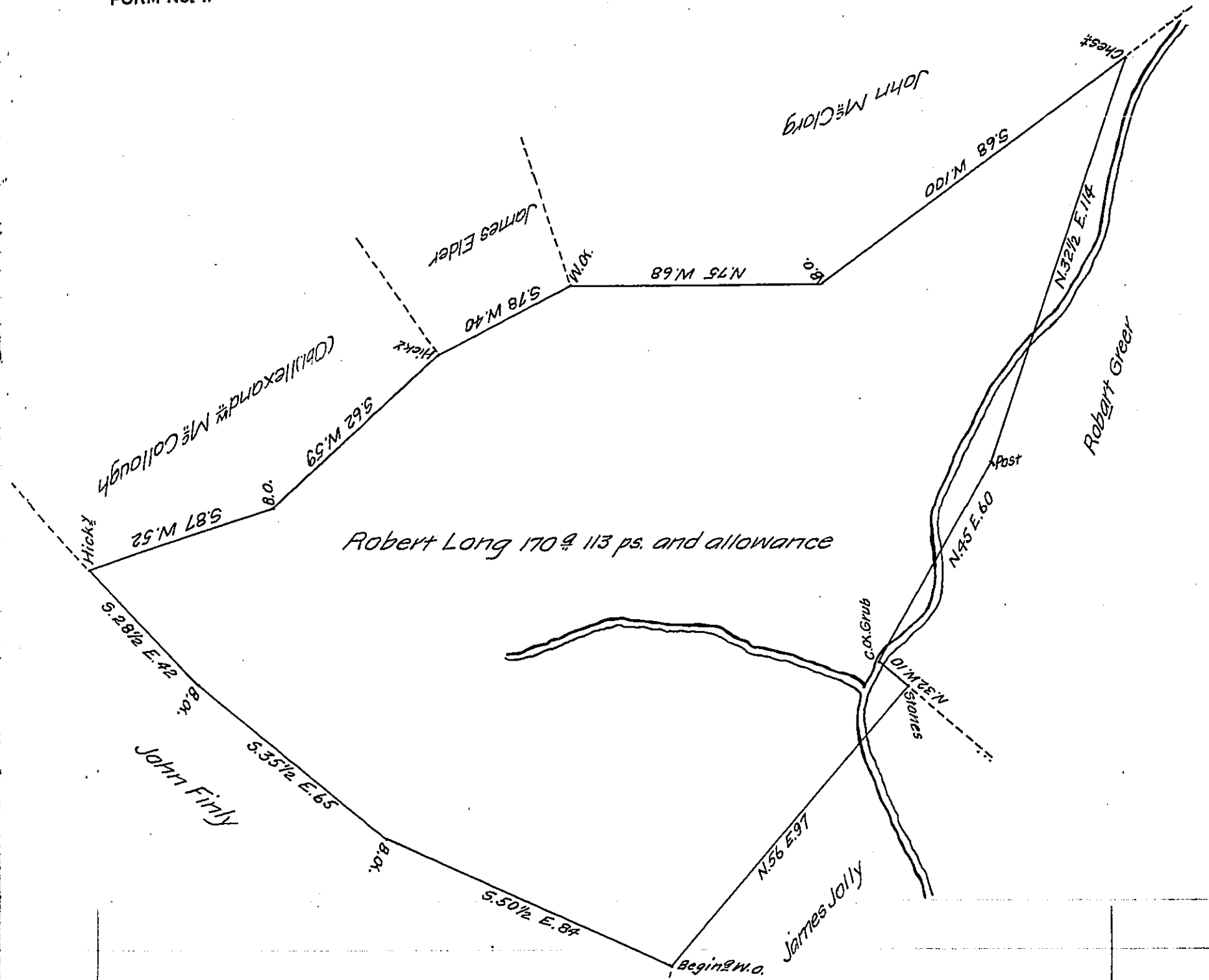

Situate in Chanceford Township York County surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of the 4<sup>th</sup> month 1775 for Robert Long part in pursuance of a Warrant for 75<sup>ac</sup> granted to a Certain Robert Summers the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1753 and of ~~and~~ a Warrant granted to said Long dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March 1775.
