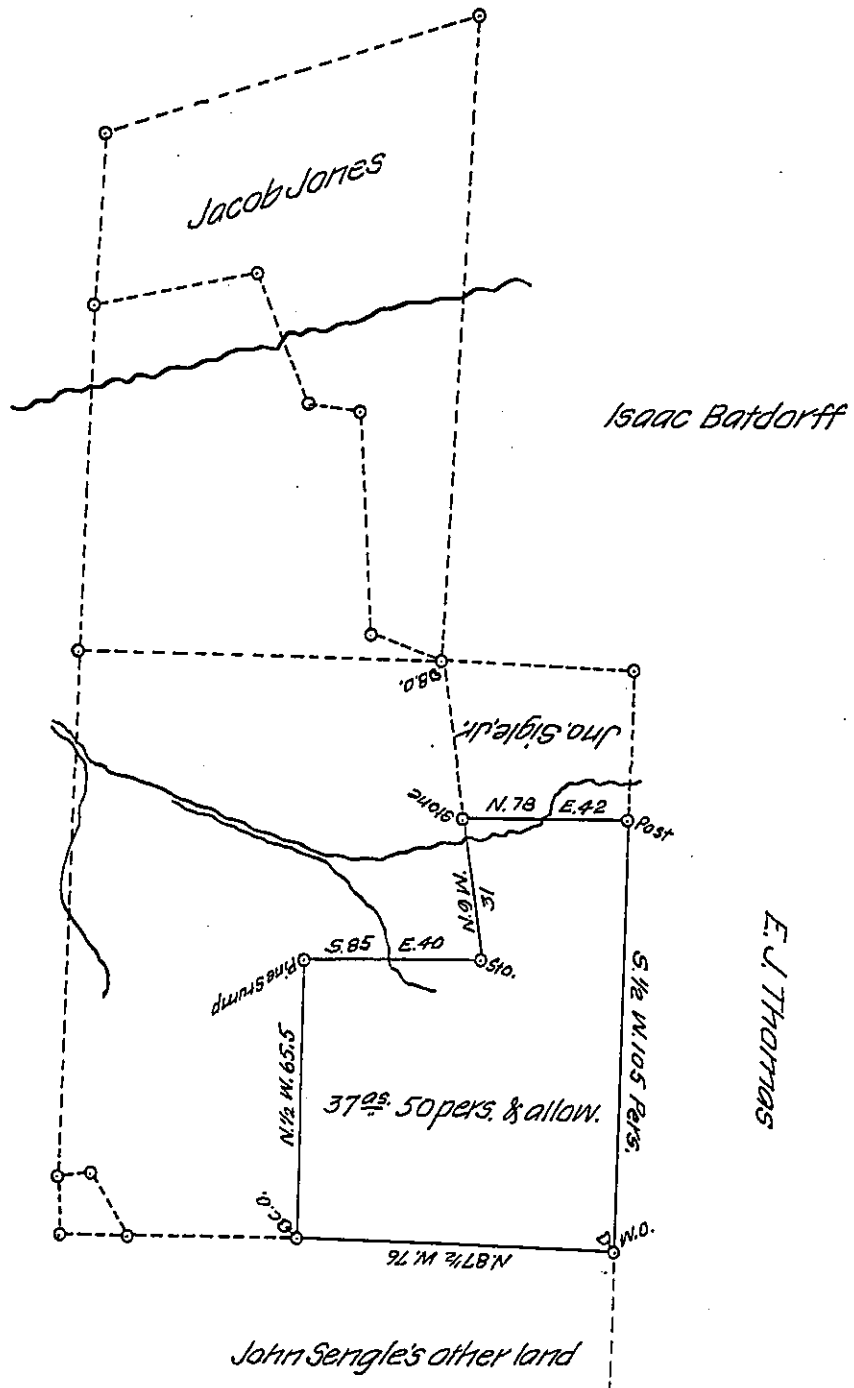


Isaac Batdorff
