



The above is a draught of an Island in the river Susquehanna in Martick township, Lancaster County Penna. Called Poor house Island, opposite to Lands of Widow Gully on the east side of the river, and William Kilgore & Hans Ringland, on the west side at ten or fifteen perches below Wild Cat Island, and above Bear Island, and contains 3 acres & 23 perches Strict measure, surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James L. McCalls dated the 31<sup>st</sup> of May 1831.
