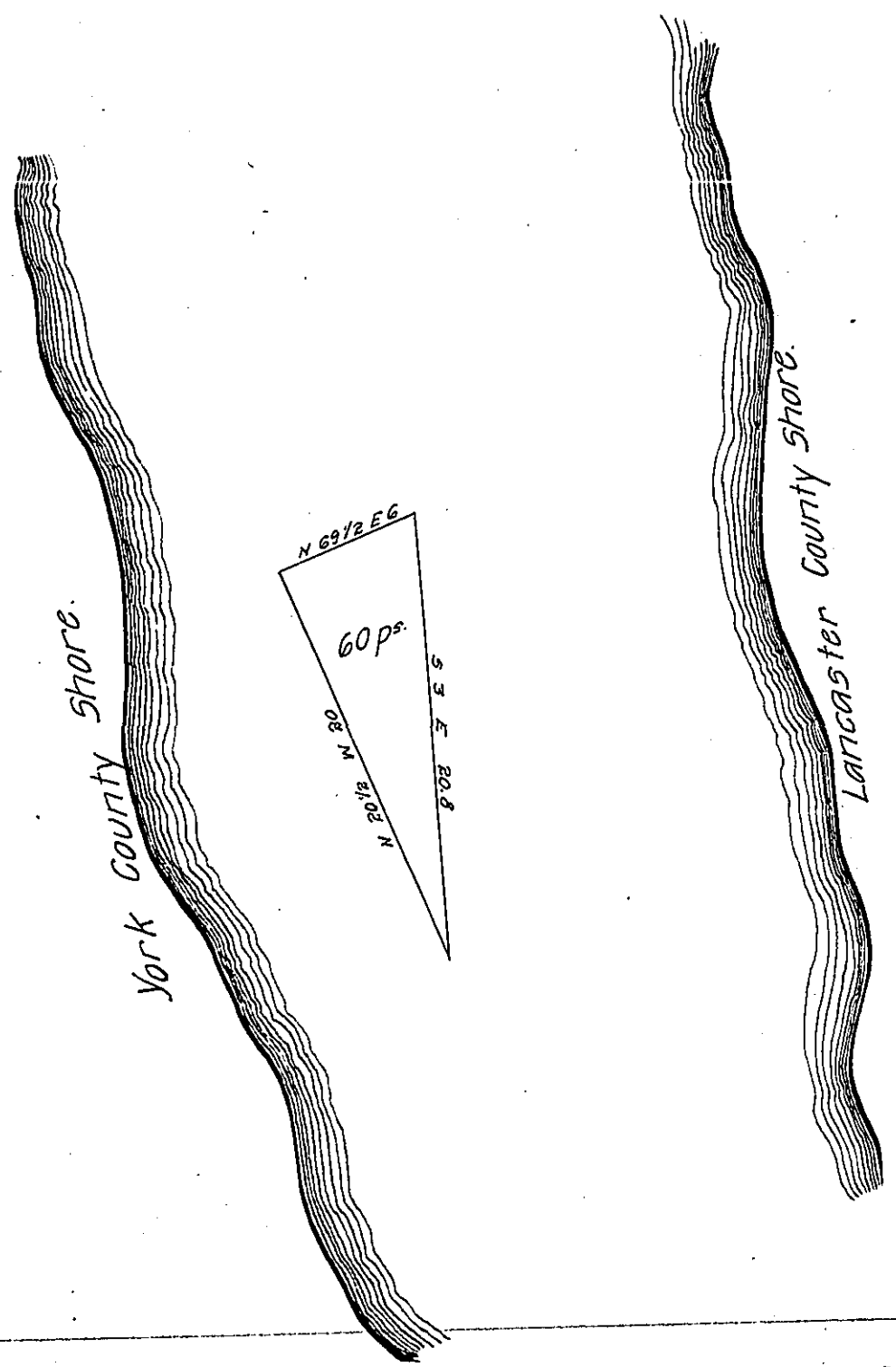


FORM NO 1.



The above is a draught of Little Duck Island, containing sixty perches strict measure, situated in the river Susquehanna, in Drumore township Lancaster. Opposite to Lands of Benjamin Hamm and on the east side of said river, and Lands of Thomas B. Coleman on the west side, surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James L. McCall, dated November 30th 1835.
