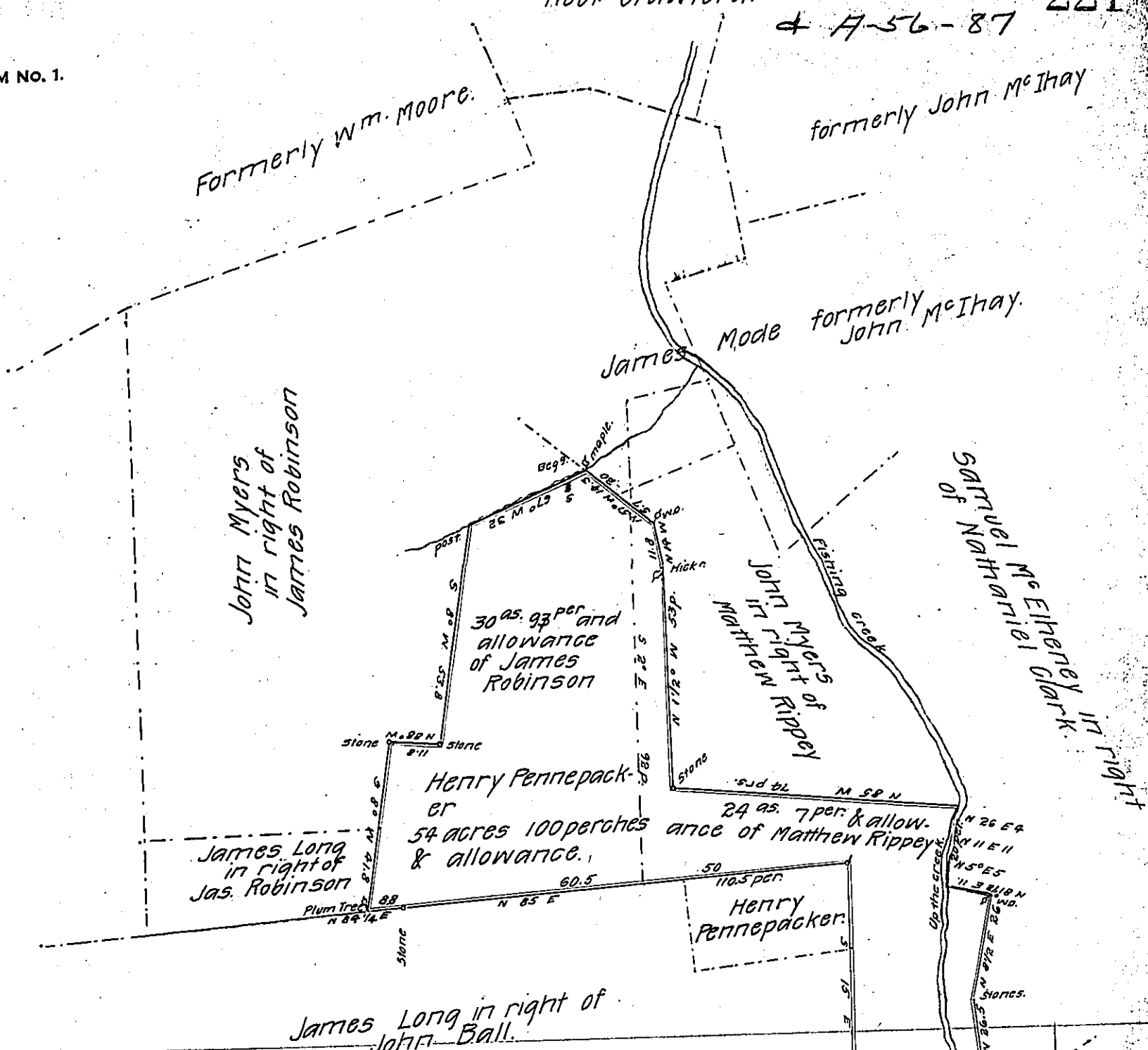

The above Draught represents the lines of a tract of Fifty four acres and one hundred perches of land and the usual allowance of six acres per cent for roads &c. Being composed of Parts of two adjoining tracts the larger one surveyed about the year 1738, in pursuance of a warrant dated the 3^d day of July A.D. 1736, granted to James Robinson, the other was surveyed the 26th of April A.D. 1753, in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 17th day of April A.D. 1752, granted to Matthew Rippey, Situate in Drumore township Lancaster County, Penna. Surveyed for Henry Pennepacker, the 20th day of April A.D. 1853. P. A. Dubree, for the Surveyor of Lancaster County;
