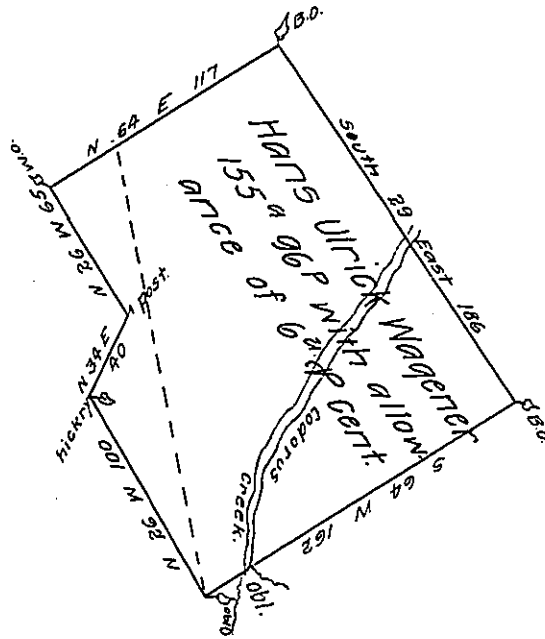

19th May 1747 Andrew Hersey 200^a on Codorus Creek over Sasquahanna in Lancaster County surveyed by virtue of two warrants one dated the 21st of July 1739 for 100^a to Alexander Davidson, the other dated the 20th day of May 1740. to Ulrick Wagener for 100^a both which are forfeited and the land ordered to be surveyed and returned to Andrew Hersey

The dotted line is intended to represent the line you run to cut off the 20^a for Michael Weidle. As ~~there is a difference both in~~ the courses & distances in your draught differ from those in Butcher's draught I desire you to examine the lines of the remaining part of the above tract which now belongs to Andreas Hersey (who must pay you) and make a return thereof into my office.
