



A draught of two hundred and twenty two acres and one hundred and fifty seven perches of land with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situate in Armagh township, Mifflin County; Surveyed Novr. 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> 1857, and Octr. 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> 1858, in pursuance of a warrant to John Treester, for 225<sup>as</sup> dated Aug 25<sup>th</sup> 1854.

Note. The line next Martin Traister not found, we were governed by the distances given on the Connected official draught.
