



By virtue of a warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of November 1747 surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August 1750 to Jacob Zanger the above described tract of land situate on a branch of Maiden Creek in the County of Northampton (formerly in the County of Bucks) containing one hundred and twenty six acres & 78 perches with allowance of 6 p.c.
