



Draft of a Tract of Land called Vesuvius Situate on the Northerly Waters of Tunkhannock Creek in the County of Luzerne adjoining Land surveyed for Samuel Nicholson containing four hundred and Seven Acres and Eighty Perches and the usual Allowance of Six per Centum for Roads. Resurveyed for Joseph Thornhill the 19th Day of August 1802 in Pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated the 28th Day of January 1802 and by Virtue of a Warrant bearing Date the 22^d Day of February 1785.
