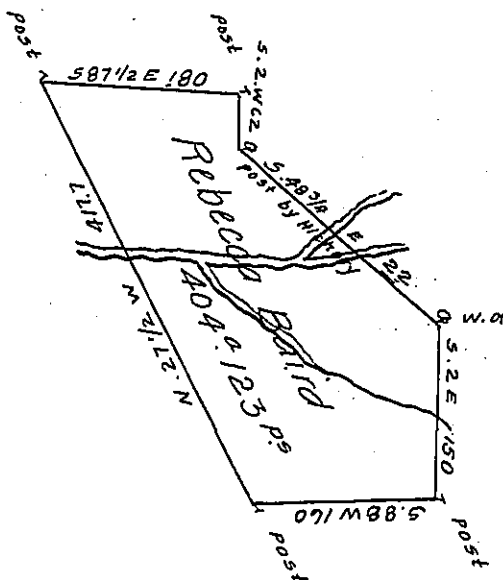


FORM No. 1.



By Virtue of a Warrant dated 17th August 1793. Surveyed 12th September 1793 to Rebecca Baird the above tract of Land Situate on a Small Brook that empties on the East Side of the Northeast Branch of Susquehanna River about half a mile below the State Line where the River passes the Same between the fifty Six and fifty Seven Mile Stones in Luzerne County Containing four hundred and four Acres and one hundred and twenty three perches and allowance of Six & Cent for Roads &c.
