



By virtue of a Warrant dated 17<sup>th</sup> August 1793. Surveyed 2<sup>d</sup> September 1793 to William Armstrong the above tract of Land Situate in Luzerne County on the branches of a Small Stream that empties on the East Side of the North East Branch of the River Susquehannah About two miles and a half below the State line and about one mile above Tioga point. Containing four hundred and thirty three Acres and one hundred & fifty four perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads and highways &c.
