



By virtue of a Warrant dated 17<sup>th</sup> August 1793. Surveyed 9<sup>th</sup> September 1793 to John Fisher the Above tract of Land Situate near the heads of ~~the~~ brook that empties on the East Side of the North East branch of Susquehanna River About half a mile below where the state line crosses Said River between the fifty six & fifty Seven Mile Stones. Containing four hundred & twelve Acres and one hundred and twenty four perches and allowance of Six & Cent for Roads &c
