



Situate on the Westerly side of Youghiogenei River about half a mile below the Cumberland Road in Henry Clay Township, Fayette County (Henry Clay township being a part of what was "Wharton" at date of the Warrant) & Surveyed the 24th day of October 1829. In pursuance of a Warrant for 40 acres in the name of S^d Blocher, dated the 18th day of January 1815.
