



On an Order issued from the land Office of Pa. dated March 28th 1865 to appraise a certain Island in the Conemaugh River which was surveyed on the 25th day of April 1865 containing ^{thirty} three acres and ^{Strict Measure} six perches ~~& allowance~~ situate in Conemaugh River on the line between Indiana & Westmoreland Counties Whereupon the land Office of Pa. granted a warrant to W^m M.
