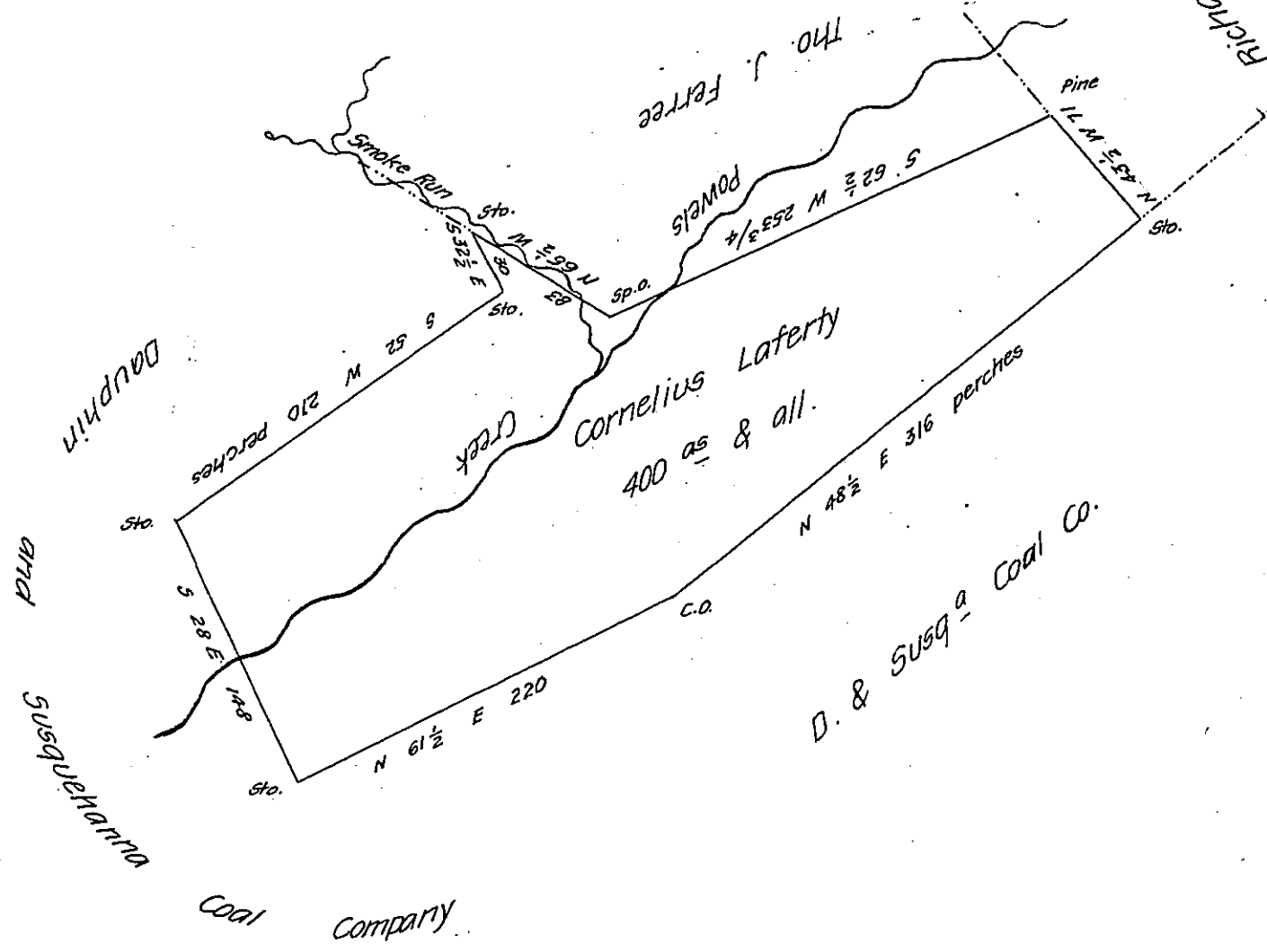

Situate on Powels Creek Jefferson township formerly Middle Paxton township Dauphin County Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Cornelius Laferty bearing date the 25th of January A.D. 1794
