Surveyed the 12th day of January 1831. for Augustavious Ross by virtue of his Warrent bearing date the 14th day of August 1830 as appears by a draught of the survey filed in my office mad- and signed by W^m Laird Esq., then D.S. which survey I examined the 11th day of August 1846 and found the original lines and corners marked on the ground bearing date with said official draught.
