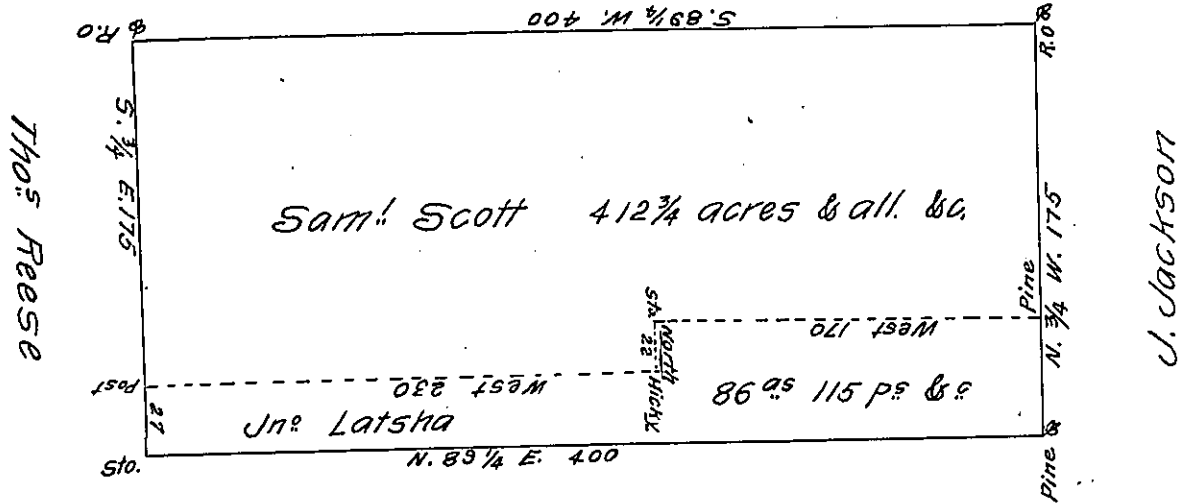


THOMAS HAMILTON

Situate in Little Mahony Township Northumberland County containing four hundred twelve acres & three-fourths and allowance of six per cent &c (including Latsha's interference of 86⁹⁵ 115 ps) surveyed unto Samuel Scott in pursuan.— of his warrant dated 14th March 1794 by W^m Gray then D.S. of North^d County— and resurveyed on the 27th day of Decer. 1828 by virtue of an order of the Board of Property granted to Hugh Bellas dated the 29th day of November 1828.
