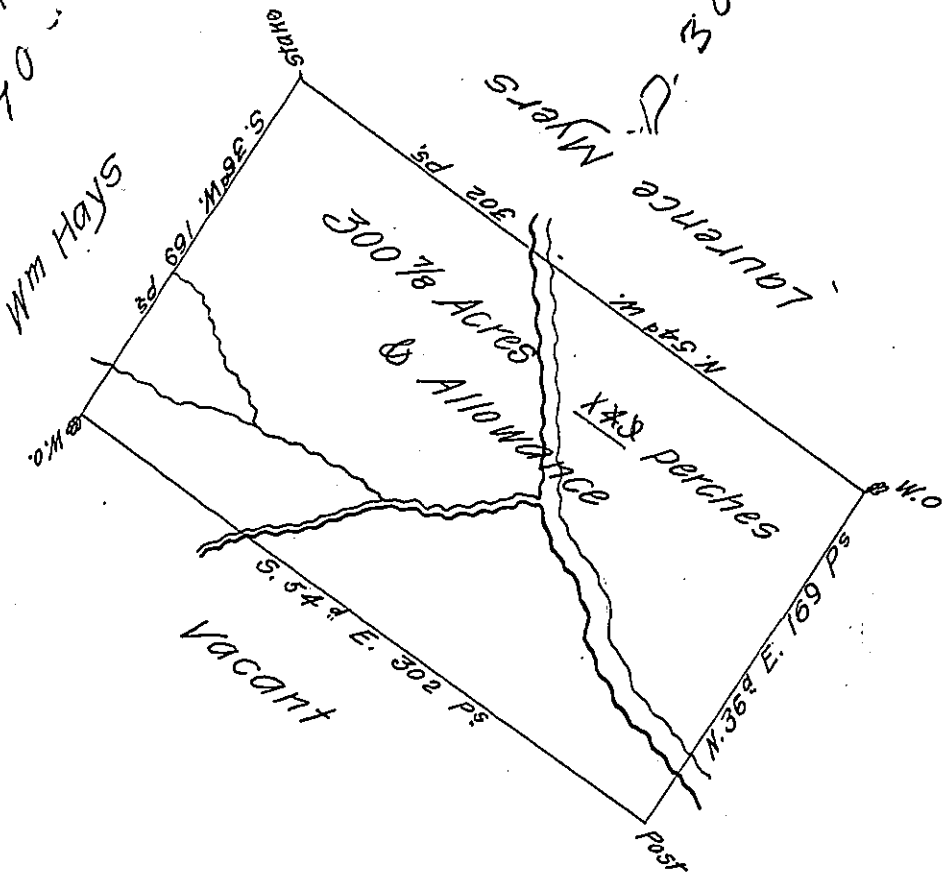

In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 2^d of Feb^y. 1784 for three hundred acres of land granted to Simon Spalding by Virtue of a Resolution of General Assembly, and to me directed was on the 29th day of April last surveyed and laid of three hundred acres and one hundred and forty-nine perches of land with the usual allowance of six Acres Pr. Cent. agreeable to the above ~~five~~ Draught situated in the forks of Fishing Creek adjoining lands surveyed for Lawrence Myers in Northumberland County -
